Your stability as a property owner is important to our community. That's why it is so important that you **get off the lien sale list before May 15th, 2015.**

You can avoid the lien sale by paying down your debt, entering into a no-money-down, 10-year payment plan or apply for an exemption. Many resources are available to help you.

- 1) Senior citizens! Disabled homeowners! Clergy! Military! **Complete the enclosed Exemption Eligibility Checklist** and mail it to the Department of Finance **today!**
- 2) Visit a Department of Finance's Business Center & work with a staff person to get off the list. The Brooklyn Business Center is located in the Brooklyn Municipal Building at 210 Joralemon Street, b/w Adams and Court Streets.
- 3) Attend the 2015 Lien Sale Help Night at Bedford Stuyvesant Restoration Corporation on Thursday, May 7th. (See details on the reverse of this page.)
