### How To Package Materials for the Event

1. Look for items with DANGER, POISON, or CAUTION labels.



2. Do not mix products.



3. Ensure products are labeled clearly.



4. Tightly seal all containers.



Only NYC residential waste will be accepted. No commercial vehicles allowed. Residents MUST provide proof of NYC residency (NYS driver's license, utility bill, etc.). For safety reasons, attendees may not unload their vehicles outside the event area. For more info: [nyc.gov/safedisposal](http://nyc.gov/safedisposal).

# Year-Round Disposal Options

**Air Conditioners:** Call 311 or request an appointment with [nyc.gov](http://nyc.gov) for CFC recovery and recycling. **Not accepted at SAFE Events.**

**Appliances:** Recycle with other rigid plastics, metal, glass, and cartons. (Remove batteries first.) **Not accepted at SAFE Events.**

**Auto Batteries:** Drop off at service stations and auto parts stores, or bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

**Cell Phones:** Drop off at cell phone service providers.

**Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFLs):** Drop off at any Home Depot, Lowe's, or Ikea, or bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

**Electronics:** Drop off at Lower East Side Ecology Center e-waste events, or at any Best Buy, Staples (no TVs), Goodwill, Salvation Army, or the Gowanus E-waste Warehouse. Apartment buildings can sign up for e-cycleNYC. Find more options at [nyc.gov/electronics](http://nyc.gov/electronics).

**Latex Paint:** Dry out and discard with garbage (recycle empty paint can), or bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

**Mercury Thermostats:** Visit [thermostat-recycle.org](http://thermostat-recycle.org) for locations, or bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

**Motor Oil:** Bring to a service station with oil changes or to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site.

**Rechargeable Batteries:** Drop off at retailers that sell them, or bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site. Alkaline batteries can go in the trash.

**Syringes:** Drop off at hospitals in a tightly sealed and clearly labeled container.

**Tires:** Drop off at businesses that sell them, bring to a DSNY Household Special Waste Drop-Off Site, or to a DSNY garage. **Not accepted at SAFE Events.**

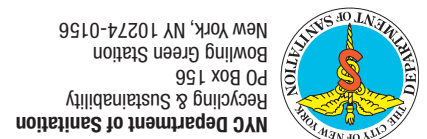
